In closing, **Black Lives Matter. Black Deaf Lives Matter**

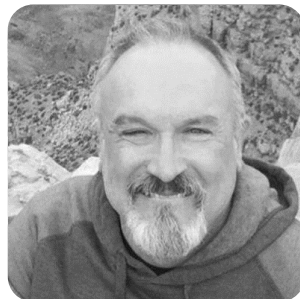

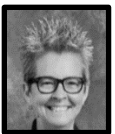
